



François Marion - Chief Executive Officer of CACEIS

François Marion, 52, graduated from the Ecole des Hautes Etudes Commerciales (HEC), Paris. He started his career at the internal audit Division of Banque Indosuez. From 1985 to 1991, he was in charge of operations for Banque Indosuez New York. In 1991, he joined the Capital markets Department in Paris and was responsible for the market risk monitoring in international branches. In 1992 in Hong Kong, he was nominated Chief Operating Officer of Banque Indosuez in the Asia-Pacific region. In 1997 following the acquisition of Banque Indosuez by Crédit Agricole, he was responsible for financial controlling, budgets and strategic planning for the Crédit Agricole Indosuez Group in Paris. In 1999, he became a member of the Executive Committee for Crédit Agricole Indosuez and Head of Systems and Operations. In June 2004, François Marion was named Managing Director of Crédit Agricole Investor Services (CA-IS). In August 2005, François Marion was nominated Chairman of the Management Board of CACEIS. In June 2009, he was appointed Chief Executive Officer of CACEIS when the group changed from being a company with a supervisory board to a company with a board of directors.

François Marion is also a director of Euroclear SA/NV and Chairman of Sicovam Holding.
